14 Sept	The Art of Being Brilliant	Guest Speaker Andy Cope, Author & Life Coach This session will empower participants to take control of their careers and provide strategies to deal with the challenges that teaching can bring, equipping them with strategies to inspire and motivate pupils.	
21 Sept	The Effectiveness of the Learning Environment	Participants will gain an understanding of the elements that can positively impact on the classroom environment. They will consider the importance of the learning environment, routines and organisation.	
21 Sept	Behaviour Management	Guest Speaker Barbara Bull, ASEND Participants will develop a range of strategies and identify ways to manage behaviour positively, with a focus on children's learning.	
28 Sept	Learning Objectives and Success Criteria	Participants will gain an understanding of how to create effective learning objectives and success criteria, using these to shape their teaching. There will be an opportunity to reflect on planning formats in this session.	
28 Sept	Marking and Feedback.	The purpose of marking, effectiveness of feedback and how feedback has a positive impact on learning and progress.	
5 Oct	Outstanding Physical Education	Participants will develop an understanding of how to teach active PE sessions with clear learning targets. Confidence in teaching PE will be built through developing safe practices in PE and Sports, as well as ensuring that the practical and physical elements are comprehensively covered, for both outdoor and indoor PE.

1 Feb	Writing, Spelling and Grammar	Participants will be introduced to 'Talk for Writing', which enables children to imitate the key language they need for a particular topic before they try reading and analysing it. This session will also explore the structure of Spelling & Grammar within the framework for English. It will help to clarify the progression of learning and teaching from FS to Y6.	
8 Feb	SEND	Guest Speaker Barbara Ball, ASEND Participants will gain an understanding of the SEND code of practice and look at strategies to support children with ASD in their classroom.	
22 Feb	Supporting Pupils with EAL	This session will focus on two main areas. It will offer ideas and tips for settling new pupils at the early stages of English acquisition into your classroom and supporting them to access the curriculum. It will also focus on a range of strategies and ideas for adapting your planning to fully meet the needs of all EAL learners.	
1 March	Good to Outstanding- Knowing the Difference	This session focuses on what makes an outstanding lesson, using the current Ofsted framework to analyse lessons and adapt planning, delivery and marking.

14 June	Effective Professional Action & Development Planning	Dr Helen Tyler, Director of Continuing Professional Development Celebrating success and reflecting on achievement whilst identifying areas for professional support and development for the year ahead. This session is specifically designed to empower teachers to take ownership of their own professional development.	
21 June	Science	An afternoon to delve into the pedagogy that supports the science curriculum. Teachers will be exposed to a range of material and ideas designed to increase confidence and effectiveness in the teaching of core science investigation skills.
