New Primary Schools For Enfield

Chase Farm and Grovelands Areas

The Lime Trust would like to open new Primary Schools (with nursery provision) in September 2017.

The schools will increase parental choice in an area where there is a growing need for additional primary school places.

A report to the Council's Cabinet on the 21 October 2015 again reported the need for a new school. Anyone can apply to set up a free school to meet this need.

Sites have not yet been agreed. The Lime Trust will work with the DfE to locate the most appropriate site to address the shortage of pupil places in areas where the need is most acute.
